

#### Measuring Economic Security Instead of Poverty

Poverty Measures Fall Far Short of Needs for All California Seniors

Average California Elder Index 2011 (single renter): \$23,317

Median California Supplemental Poverty Measure 2011(single renter): \$14,268

Federal Poverty Guidelines 2011: \$10.890


